

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR HEART FOR MUSLIMS NETWORKER AND MINISTRY/CHURCH LIAISON

Job Description Summary. The Heart for Muslims Networker and Ministry/Church Liaison will help connect Metro New York Christians to local ministry opportunities among Muslims. This person will network widely with churches, ministries, and Christian networks throughout the city (and beyond) to spread the vision of reaching Muslims in, and through, Metro New York. He or she will catalyze strategic connections and partnerships for gospel advance among Muslim communities.

Major Responsibilities and Functions

- Help bridge churches and missionaries in Metro New York by letting churches know of training and outreach opportunities, and letting missionaries know of churches with Muslim-background Christians or who have an interest in reaching Muslims.
- Create learning and corporate prayer platforms with people who are marginally or fully invested in reaching Muslims.
- Find ways to foster unity among Kingdom workers in Metro New York who have a common vision to see Muslim-background people follow Christ and spread the gospel to their people.
- Help Heart for Muslims expand beyond an annual conference to a yearly initiative in line with our vision of loving Muslims, equipping the Body of Christ, and connecting them for local service.
- Represent Muslim-focused work and needs in other networks of Christians throughout the metropolitan area.
- Keep up with the progress of evangelism and church planting among [all major Muslim people group communities in Metro New York](#) by staying up to date with local missionaries' newsletters, Facebook posts, etc.
- Lead or facilitate trainings in Metro New York to help Christians engage Muslim communities with service, hospitality, and evangelism.
- Through writing, speaking, social media, and video, promote mission opportunities among Muslims in Metro New York.
- Raise up financial supporters to support your work.

Why is a Heart for Muslims Networker and Ministry/Church Liaison Needed?

Metro New York has around one million Muslims, the largest Muslim population by far in North America. Since 2015, Heart for Muslims has helped serve as a collaborative enterprise to network and bless the expanding number of Muslim-focused missionaries and mission organizations in the city. Due



to the diversity of denominational and ethnic networks among the Body of Christ in Metro New York, it takes intentionality and time for someone to develop relationships with these networks to know about their existing interactions with Muslims, and to let them know of further opportunities in the city. Many churches in Metro New York focus their attention on shepherding their busy members and often need outside assistance in envisioning and embracing missional opportunities among Muslims who, among Jewish groups, represent the communities most in need of gospel witness in the city.



Place of Residence

The Networker and Ministry/Church Liaison may live anywhere in Metro New York but will need to travel extensively throughout Metro New York by car and public transport. Queens, Brooklyn, the Bronx, and northern New Jersey have the greatest populations of Muslims.

Accountability

- Submit short monthly reports to the Heart for Muslims executive team.
- Meet reporting requirements of the agency or church from which the Network and Ministry/Church Liaison receives financial support (if the candidate needs to find an organization to come under, Heart for Muslims can assist with possibilities).



Characteristics

- Demonstrates a mature walk with God as verified by lifestyle and references.
- Demonstrates a thorough understanding of the Bible with its overarching narrative and can articulate the major tenets of the Christian faith to others.
- Evidences God's calling, gifting, and leading to reach Muslims with the gospel.
- Is personable and can relate well to people of various socio-economic levels, Christian denominations, races, and ethnicities.
- Is age twenty-one or older (no maximum age).
- Has a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Has the experience to fulfill the job assignment.
- Is legally able to work in the USA or country of operation.
- Models healthy family relationships ([click here](#) to view the family standards of Heart for Muslims' organizational accountability).
- Has no credit card debt and all other loans (student, mortgage, etc.) are manageable.
- Shows evidence of good emotional, physical, financial and mental health.
- Demonstrates a healthy relationship with a local evangelical church.
- Agrees with the [Lausanne Covenant](#) and [mission of Heart for Muslims](#).
- Demonstrates relational skills to network with partners for raising salary and ministry support.
